NOTES TO STATEMENT OF INVESTMENTS (UNAUDITED)

Templeton Dragon Fund, Inc. (the Fund) is registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940 as a non-diversified closed-end investment company.

ITEM 2. CONTROLS AND PROCEDURES.
