The Series A Convertible Preferred Stock, Series B Convertible Preferred Stock, Series B-1 Convertible Preferred Stock and Series C Convertible Preferred stock automatically convert into shares of Issuer's common stock immediately prior to the completion of Issuer's initial public offering.
- (1) Preferred Stock and Series C Convertible Preferred stock automatically convert into shares of Issuer's common stock immediately prior to the completion of Issuer's initial public offering.
 - (2) The expiration date is not relevant to the conversion of these securities.
